HEB 1201 Hebrew I (5 Credits)

Surveys the essentials of biblical Hebrew, including grammar, morphology, syntax, and vocabulary, through the translation of selected Old Testament texts. Typically offered: Autumn.

HEB 1202 Hebrew II (5 Credits)
